Ongoing Projects

1. **Eyeglass Project** – This is the 3rd time for the eyeglass project and we were able to provide 45 pairs of glasses. Some folks just use them for reading, while others need them to see everything. One older lady commented. "I can see the leaves on the trees again". What a joy to see the smiles on their faces.

2. **Cricket Project** – Last year our family and one other lady – Sagnuan raised crickets for a full year to learn the cycles of a cricket and the best way to raise them. In the beginning of April we were able to use our new skill of cricket breeding © and help five families start raising cricket on their own. Each family received 3 bins and starter crickets. Sagnuan taught the group the whole process and the do's and don'ts of raising crickets. Crickets are a good source of protein and the folks here enjoy eating them. They can be eaten stir fried or chopped up for other meat dishes.

CULTURAL TID-BIT "พิธีผีปอบ"

" Evil Spirit Ceremony"

There have been three deaths and five ladies possessed by spirits in a short amount of time. The people are in fear and have asked the village leadership to find a specialist that can chase the evil spirits out of the village. Money is collected from the whole village, a ceremony is performed, evil spirits are chased around the village and captured in jars and lastly special made wreaths are made and placed at each house and on the entrance to the village to let the evil spirits know they are not wanted in the village. Recently our English students all came to class wearing extra amulets around their necks and strings tied around their wrists. They all were expressing their fear of the spirits, afraid of being attacked next. – Pray these folks will accept Christ, Who has the power over the spirits.
