We have always tried and want to continue to be upfront and as clear as possible with you in regards to our ministry. We know that it is your desire to be a good steward of what God has entrusted to you. We are grateful that you have chosen to support us as missionaries that are focused on expanding the reach of the Gospel to those who have never heard the name of Jesus Christ. 1) We are missionaries to the foreign field [Specifically unreached peoples]

As the world's 3rd largest evangelical missions organization, New Tribes Mission has missionaries who are currently working with 269 people groups worldwide in 31 different countries. Considering our focus is church planting and Bible translation amongst unreached people groups, we work primarily in the 10/40 window, as well as Central and South America. We are privileged to be playing a direct role in reaching the most unreached people on the planet today by training and preparing students who will be the next generation of career missionaries to the far corners of the Earth.

Many of you attended our presentation last August where we showed the value and necessity of each role played by NTM missionaries in order to effectively carry out our Lord's command to take the Gospel to the ends of the Earth. We showed how the whole team works together; from the missionaries in the tribes to those working on the support bases, then all the way back here to the US to those training all the others, and the financial supporters. A good illustration would be the armed forces: Some are across enemy lines, others are at base camps, still others are here in the States training and preparing new soldiers to depart to foreign lands, and others are financial supporters.

But more vital than each individual role in the missionary chain is that of the local Church and individual supporters. Your support s the crucial link that allows all of the others to function (Rom 10:15).
