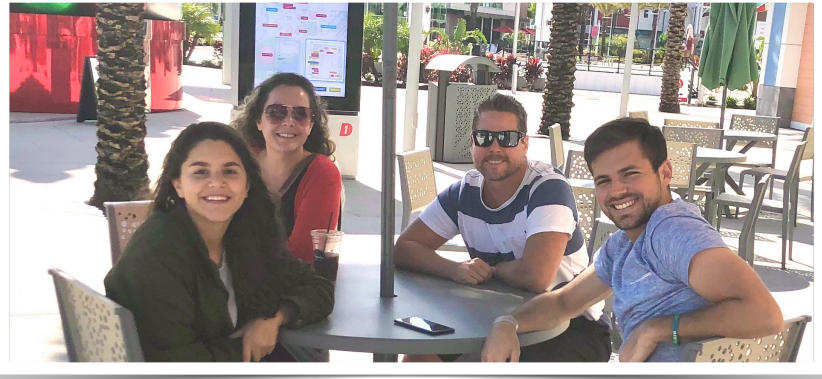


The Pei People - Papua New Guinea

Representing the Unreached

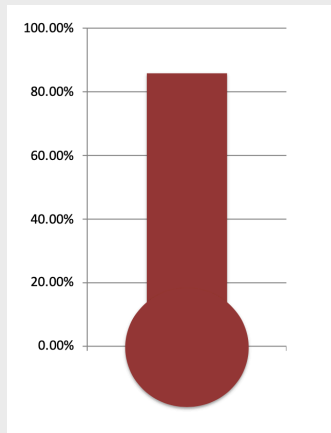

Financial Needs

We know that many people are facing financial hardship this year. We have lost some support but thankfully many have been able to continue. For those still able to contribute, here are our needs.

Monthly Gifts

Regular monthly or annual contributions are what provides for our income and ministry expenses.



We are currently receiving 86% of our recommended support level.

We have supporters between \$20-\$350/mo. Your regular contribution of *any* amount help to make that possible.
